## SPRING 2010 FISH STOCKING

**Triploid Grass Carp (10-12") @ \$20 ea.; Koi (6-8") @ \$14 ea.; Catfish (6") @ \$3 ea.;  
Goldfish (4-6") @ \$7 ea.; Fathead Minnows (1-1.5") @ \$20/100**

---

- Note:** 1) You NEED a Triploid Grass Carp permit to buy carp. If you do not have a permit, call the regional Fisheries Office of the NYSDEC in Avon at (585) 226-5343 to obtain an application. Koi, goldfish, minnows, and catfish DO NOT require a permit in order to be purchased.
- 2) You **MUST** obtain a free Farm Fish Pond License to stock fish. To obtain an application call the regional Fisheries Office of the NYSDEC in Avon at (585) 226-5343. Permits are good for 5 years.
- 3) **Recommended Stocking Rates Per Acre:** Koi – 10; Goldfish – 200; Minnows – 2,000; Catfish – 200. For Triploid Grass Carp, the recommended stocking rates are per the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) approved permit.
- 4) Triploid Grass Carp control aquatic vegetation by consuming various types of soft stemmed plants. Koi and Goldfish do eat algae, but will not control algae growth. Some of our customers have successfully used barley straw to reduce new algae growth. **ALL ORDERS MUST BE RECEIVED WITH PAYMENT ON OR BEFORE MAY 28, 2010**

**Scheduled delivery is JUNE 4, 2010, from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** Distribution will be in the MCSWCD parking area on the east side of Building A for 1 hour only. We have no holding facilities; please keep in mind that the hatchery will deliver, distribute, and leave after this 1 hour period. You must arrive during this distribution time or you will forfeit your order. No Refunds. You will need to bring 20 gallons of pond or lake water for every 6 Grass Carp, 10 Koi, 30 Catfish, 30 Goldfish, 500 minnows, for a travel time of 30-45 minutes.

**DO NOT USE TAP WATER OR WELL WATER!**

**Important Note:** Please bring a cover for the container(s) of water, so that the water does not splash around. A garbage bag with a tie works best; this also keeps the fish in, since the carp are jumpers!

**DO NOT FORGET YOUR NYS DEC PERMIT (3 copies) WHEN YOU COME TO PICK UP YOUR CARP. NO PERMIT=NO GRASS CARP.**

**If you are unable to obtain your permit before the pick-up date, please notify us as soon as possible.**

The Soil & Water Conservation District is not responsible for fish after they leave the pick-up area.
